On page 46, Florida has 16 Republicans and 11 Democrats in the House.

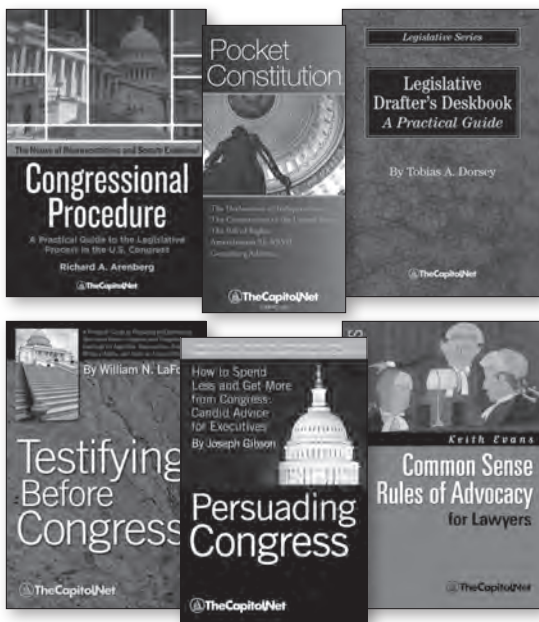
On page 100, North Carolina has 8 Republicans and 5 Democrats in the House.
